Student Ambassadors

Head Girl & Head Boy

The role of Head Girl & Head Boy is to represent the school and act as ambassadors and role models through their conduct on a daily basis and at whole school events.

The Head Girl & Head Boy will be required to deliver speeches, tours and readings at events.

They will take a lead in ensuring Student Voice is effective and that decisions agreed upon are carried out.

The Head Girl & Head Boy will liaise with members of the staff, Senior Leadership Team and other stakeholders on a regular basis to support the continuing improvement of the school.

The Head Girl & Head Boy will be responsible for leading the student ambassadors and assigning duties.

The Head Girl & Head Boy will also organise and chair regular meetings with the student leadership team. It is their duty to ensure student leaders are supported and they will be accountable for ensuring all student leaders are fulfilling their responsibilities and meeting the expectations of their roles.

Deputy Head Girl & Deputy Head Boy

The role of the Deputy Head Girl & Deputy Head Boy is to represent the school and act as ambassadors and role models through their conduct on a daily basis and at whole school events.

The Deputy Head Girl & Deputy Head Boy supports the Head Girl & Head Boy in their duties and deputises when required.

Student Ambassadors

Student Ambassadors will work as a team to carry out assigned duties including supporting other students, organising charity and social events and supporting and promoting the work of Student Voice.
